Participation Rules And Guidelines

By participating in Psychedelic Art Week (the "Event") you agree to the following rules and guidelines:

SET UP AND TAKE DOWN

Artists selected for in-person exhibition will provide all necessary equipment and be responsible for installing and uninstalling their work.* Artists may begin installing their work at **12:00 pm** at the selected location on the day of the event. Artists will have completed installation of their work by **4:00 pm** and will not begin uninstalling their work until the end of the Event. Artists can begin uninstalling their work immediately at the end of the Event and will be completed with their uninstal by **2:00 pm, February 11th**. The artist understands that nothing can be hung from the walls or ceiling of either venue.

ATTENDANCE

Artists can attend the entirety of the Event free of charge and be available to discuss their work with attendees at all times during the Event. Artists may also bring one guest free of charge. The Event will be held as follows:

- **February 4th - 10th:** Virtual Gallery (all selected works);
- **February 9th:** Live Display at Psychedelic Networking Reception at The NODE (by special invitation);
- **February 10th:** Live Display at Kaleidoscope Encounter Open House at Underground Art Gallery Chicago (by special invitation).

SALES

Any sales of any work at the Event will be between the purchaser and the Artist at a price the Artist determines in advance and lists on the Call For Art Form. IPS will accept digital payment for the artwork and will tender the sales price minus a **20 percent donation back to IPS** to the Artist at the end of the Event. The Artist agrees to inform IPS staff or Board members of any other sales and the price of those sales should a patron make a sale with the Artist not through IPS and shall provide IPS with 20 percent of any such sale. The Artist may remit such donation to IPS at 1223 N 6th St Chillicothe, IL 61523 in cash or check made out to The Illinois Psychedelic Society at the end of the Event or by digital payment via the IPS website. An Artist may also remit the donation to IPS within 7 days of the Event by mail at this address or by donation via the IPS website. Artist acknowledges that IPS has not guaranteed the sale or sale price of any work displayed at the Event.

LIABILITY AND NO INSURANCE

Artist acknowledges that IPS will not insure any work provided by Artist at the Event. If Artist would like to obtain insurance on their work, they may do so at Artist's expense. Artist hereby understands and acknowledges that IPS is not liable for any damage to or loss of Artist's work, equipment, or other materials. Artist hereby waives and releases IPS from any and all claims, liability, causes of action, or damages related to any damage or loss incurred in relation to the Event.

DIGITAL IMAGES AND USE OF IMAGES

Artists shall transmit by email digital photographs of each piece of art they wish to display at least 30 days prior to the Event (by January 4th, 2024). Artist also gives permission for IPS to host and display said digital photographs on its website prior to the event in order to assist in sales of the artwork being displayed and sold at the Event. IPS may photograph any work and use Artist's name and image for purposes of publicity and other promotional purposes. Artists may not use IPS or the IPS name, logo, trademark, etc. in any way or in any manner without the prior written approval of IPS.

*If the Artist is not able to provide the equipment to display their work, please contact your Psychedelic Art Week contact or Jordan Dobrowski (jordan@willowandleafcounseling.com) at least 30 days prior to the Event (by January 4, 2024) so that arrangements can be made in advance to display work.
